



# Driving the I-43 and Moorland Road Multi-lane South Roundabout (from the south)

## Large vehicles

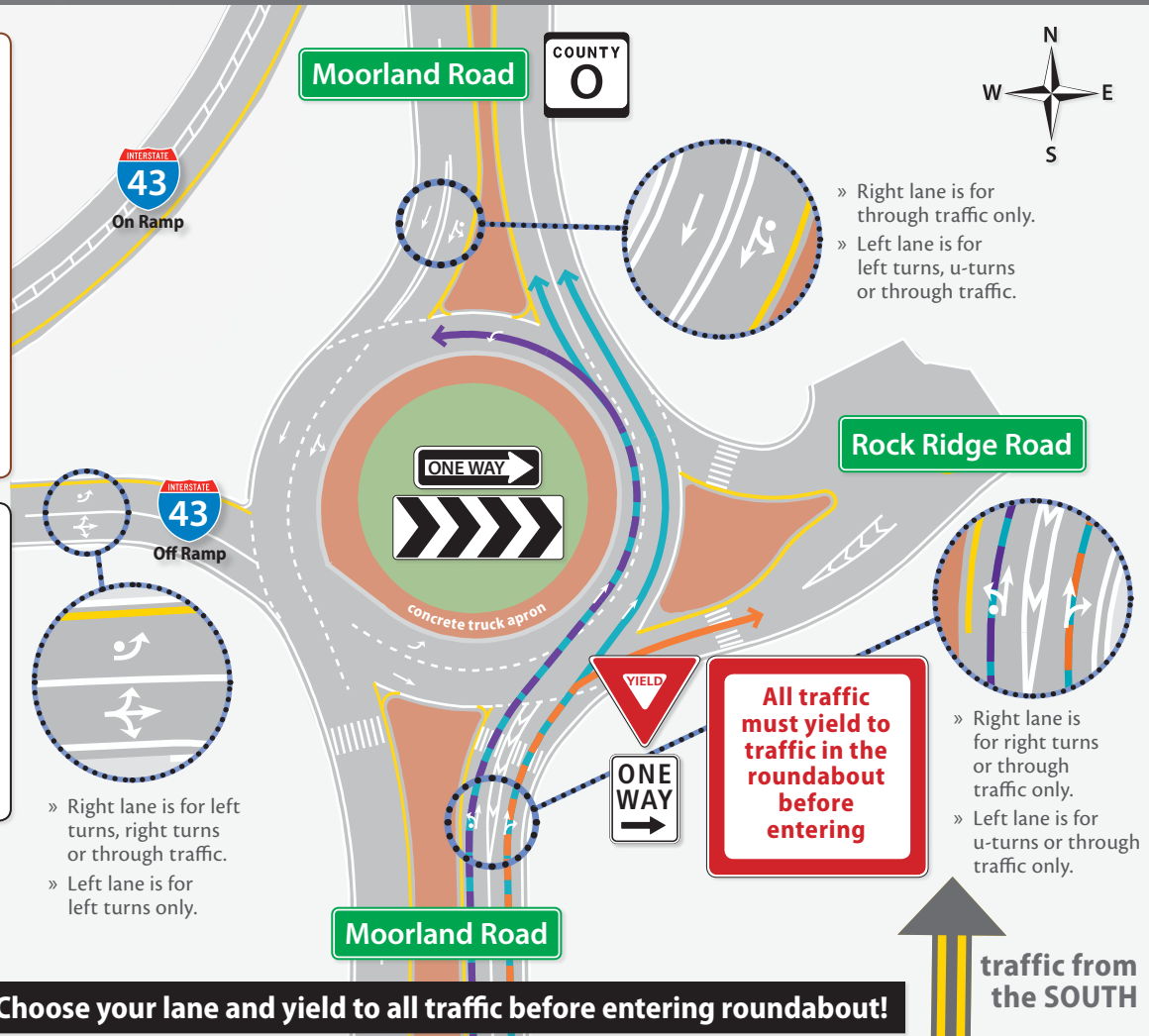
Large vehicles may straddle entering lanes and circulating lanes or may use the colored concrete truck apron that borders the inside of the roundabout.

All drivers should be cautious and avoid driving next to or passing large trucks while approaching and maneuvering through a roundabout.

## Bicycles

The same rules for vehicles apply for bicycles in the roundabout.

Ride close to the middle of the lane to prevent cars from passing and cutting you off.



- » Right lane is for through traffic only.
- » Left lane is for left turns, u-turns or through traffic.

- » Right lane is for left turns, right turns or through traffic.
- » Left lane is for left turns only.

**All traffic must yield to traffic in the roundabout before entering**

- » Right lane is for right turns or through traffic only.
- » Left lane is for u-turns or through traffic only.

**Choose your lane and yield to all traffic before entering roundabout!**

### Left turns, use either lane U-turns, use left lane

- » When approaching the roundabout, use the left lane, or other lanes that are signed and marked as a left turn lane.
- » Yield to pedestrians in the crosswalk.
- » Yield to all traffic on your left before entering the roundabout.
- » Enter the roundabout when there is a safe gap in traffic.
- » Stay in your lane.
- » Use your right turn signal to exit the roundabout.
- » Yield to pedestrians in the crosswalk at the exit.

### Going straight use appropriate lane

- » When approaching the roundabout, choose the correct lane for your desired exit.
- » Yield to pedestrians in the crosswalk.
- » Yield to all traffic on your left before entering the roundabout.
- » Enter the roundabout when there is a safe gap in traffic.
- » Stay in your lane.
- » Use your right turn signal to exit the roundabout.
- » Yield to pedestrians in the crosswalk at the exit.

### Right turns, use right lane

- » When approaching the roundabout, use the right lane, or other lanes that are signed and marked as a right turn lane.
- » Yield to pedestrians in the crosswalk.
- » Yield to all traffic on your left before entering the roundabout.
- » Enter the roundabout when there is a safe gap in traffic.
- » Stay in your lane.
- » Use your right turn signal to exit the roundabout.
- » Yield to pedestrians in the crosswalk at the exit.

### Emergency vehicles

- » Always yield to emergency vehicles.
- » If you haven't entered the roundabout, pull over to the right allowing emergency vehicles to pass.
- » If you have entered the roundabout, continue to your exit, then pull over and allow emergency vehicles to pass.
- » Avoid stopping in the roundabout.
